### Logging into ThinkCentral

Click Reading & Language Arts, then Journeys.



Select your state, district, and school (you can click the box to remember your location). You may want to bookmark this page. Enter your login username and password. Click “**Remember My School**” to avoid the need to fill in the top 3 boxes at next login. This is especially recommended for students!

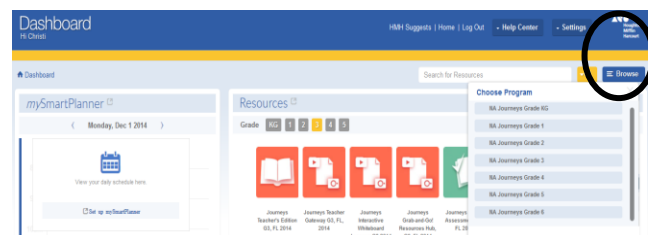

### Locating Teacher and Student Resources






There are 2 relatively simple ways to access student and teacher resources. If you are not feeling success with one way, try the other. A description of each follows.

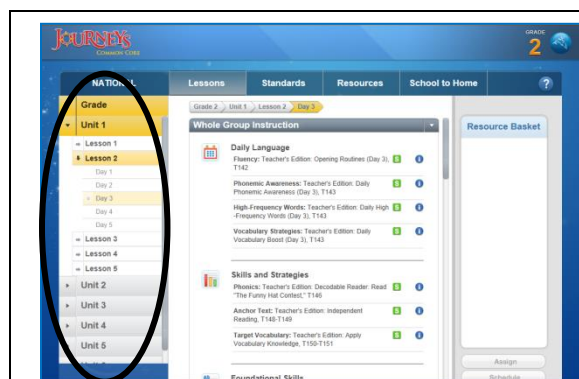


### Browse

From your Dashboard, select Browse toward the top right.

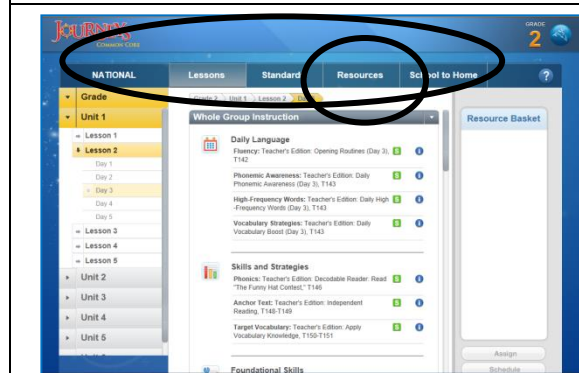
Next, select your grade level from the dropdown options.

	<p>Click Program Structure, Grade Level Resources, Unit, and Lesson to display the variety of Resources available.</p> <p>The sections, “Focus Wall,” “Whole Group Instructions,” “Langauage Arts,” etc are all hyperlinks.</p>
	<p>“Drill deeper” by clicking the Day in order to display resources for that specific day.</p>
	<p>The sections (in this case showing Small Group Instruction, Additional Support, and Response to Intervention) are hyperlinked to list resources.</p> <p>On the left, after clicking on “Response to Intervention,” the TE and the Write-In Reader are displayed. Simply clicking on “Write-In Reader: Lesson 1, Day 3, Icos Goes to School” will open that resource in a separate window.</p>
	<p>The 2<sup>nd</sup> way to access resources is via the <b><u>Gateway</u></b>.</p> <p>From your Dashboard, notice the icons that appear in the carousel. These are the most-commonly accessed Resources.</p> <p>Clicking on the Teacher Gateway icon will provide you access to all digital resources based on the Grade, Unit, and Lesson you select. If your computer does not seem to be opening any Resources within Think Central, your computer is probably not allowing “pop-ups.”</p> 



The **Teacher Gateway** will provide access to resources for a particular Unit, Lesson, or day. Again, drill down from Unit / Lesson / Day to get more specific. The items listed in the center of the window are hyperlinks and will open the resources for you. Simply click the name of the item to open it.

(S = Schedule, A = Assign, and I = Information)



Notice the tabs across the top of your window: Lessons, Standards, Resources, and School to Home. Click Resources.

Each of these tabs provide access to TE, SE, etc. Simply click on the name of the item, and it will open in a separate window. Notice all of the specific categories of resources.
